The Montclair Art Museum seeks to hire a creative **Art Truck Teaching Artist**.

**Seasonal position, now through the fall. Evening and weekend work as needed.**

**POSITION DESCRIPTION:**

The MAM Art Truck is a mobile studio, housed in a retrofitted ice cream truck, that offers art-making workshops to MAM’s community. The truck seeks to raise visibility for the Museum in surrounding towns while engaging area audiences creatively, including in underserved neighborhoods. Events include festivals and community events, artist residencies at schools and local organizations, and birthday parties.

The MAM Art Truck Teaching Artist is part of a team responsible for developing and leading a variety of projects including large scale murals, ceramics, recycled art sculpture, printmaking, and collage. **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Experience teaching hands-on arts workshops in a variety of media to people of all ages
- Experience designing and implementing art curriculum
- Knowledge of arts education principles and best practices a plus
- Ability to create safe, inclusive, and creative learning environments
- Must have strong communication skills, be outgoing, and have the ability to work well with a variety of ages, from preschool students to seniors.
- Strong organizational skills and attention to detail, can manage multiple tasks, plan ahead, anticipate and articulate program needs, and work independently
- Ability to problem-solve and be flexible
- Must have a valid driver’s license and be able to drive a retrofitted ice cream truck with automatic shift up to 20 miles. Will need to pass a driving test with Museum staff.
- This position requires some physical activity, including loading and unloading chairs, tables, and art supplies.

**HOURS:**

This position required flexible hours, including school hours, after school, and weekends. On average, the Art Truck Teaching Artist will teach 4-10 hours per week from May to October.
